Description:

For more than 50 years, Title X family planning sites have played a critical role in ensuring access to a broad range of family planning and related preventive health services for millions of low-income or uninsured individuals and others. This forecasted funding opportunity announcement seeks applications from public and private nonprofit entities to establish and operate voluntary family planning services in communities across the United States. The funding opportunity for family planning service grants will focus on supporting national efforts to achieve health equity by implementing and expanding access to affordable, client-centered, quality family planning services, with a priority to provide services to low-income clients.

OPA anticipates funding awards for up to a 5 year project period. Funding is typically awarded in 1 year budget periods after the first budget period based on a non-competing continuation application. Continuation awards are subject to the recipient's progress and management practices, and the availability of funds. In all cases, continuation awards require a determination by HHS that continued funding is in the best interest of the government. (42 CFR 59.8(b))

Applicants under this announcement will be eligible to apply under announcement number PA-FPH-22-002, "Family Planning Telehealth Infrastructure Enhancement and Expansion Grants." This second opportunity is optional. Submitting an application under PA-FPH-22-002 will have no effect on the scoring of an application under PA-FPH-22-001.
