 County governments  
 Public housing authorities/Indian housing authorities  
 Nonprofits that do not have a 501(c)(3) status with the IRS, other than institutions of higher education  
 Independent school districts  
 Public and State controlled institutions of higher education  
 Native American tribal governments (Federally recognized)  
 Native American tribal organizations (other than Federally recognized tribal governments)

**Additional Information on Eligibility:** Individuals and For-Profit Organizations are ineligible to apply for awards under this NOFO. This program NOFO does not support entities hiring interns or crews under the Public Lands Corps Act of 1993. The Public Lands Corps Act of 1993, 16 USC, Chapter 37, Subchapter II-Public Lands Corps, is the only legislative authority that allows BLM to "hire" interns under this authority. Therefore, eligible Youth Conservation Corps may only apply for projects developed under NOFO 15.243 – BLM Youth Conservation Opportunities on Public Lands.
