Through project-based funding, the program supports

opportunities for public engagement with the arts and arts education, for the integration of the arts with strategies

promoting the health and well-being of people and

communities, and for the improvement of overall capacity and capabilities within the arts sector. We welcome applications from a variety of eligible organizations, including first-time applicants; from organizations serving rural, urban, suburban, and tribal communities of all sizes; and from organizations with small, medium, or large operating budgets. An organization may submit only one application under these FY2025 Grants for Arts Projects guidelines. If an organization applies to the Challenge America category, it may not also apply to the Grants for Arts Projects category. The National Endowment for the Arts' support of a project may start on or after January 1, 2024. Generally, a period of performance of up to two years is allowed.
