nations to enhance their ability to prevent, protect against, respond to, and recover from potential terrorist attacks and

other hazards. The program directly supports FEMA national priority areas including enhancing cybersecurity, enhancing

the protection of soft targets/crowded places, enhancing

information and intelligence sharing and analysis, combating domestic violent extremism, enhancing community

preparedness and resilience, and enhancing election security.
